

# PERFUME STYLUS

Instructions

#### **Kit Features**

- · Easy to turn and assemble
- Turn straight "bushing to bushing" or with whatever artistic flair you choose
- Perfume Applicator (RE-PERF5)
- Stylus Tip (RE-STY-PERF)
- Overall Length: 5"

#### **Required Accessories & Materials**

(Line up finished parts according to Diagram A)

3. Press other Threaded Coupler into Lower Tube.

1. Press the end cap into the Upper Tube.

6. Insert Wick into the Lower Tube Assembly.

5. Reassemble Stylus & Dombed Stylus Cover to the Assembly.

9. Screw on Cap Assembly and your Perfume Stylus is complete.

4. To prevent damage during assembly, remove the Domed Stylus

Cover & Stylus from the Stylus Tip Assembly. Press remaining

with covered jaws or one of WoodTurningz' pen presses.

- 7mm mandrel
- 3-pc. bushing set PKPERFSTYBU
- 8mm drill bit (DB8MM)
- Glue (We recommend the thick "gel" CA glue—GTHICK2)
- · Sanding and finishing supplies

### **BLANK PREPARATION**

The tubes in the Perfume Stylus kit are 2-11/16" and 1-5/16" long. **Cut** your blanks approximately 1/16" longer than the tube to allow for squaring with the barrel trimmer. If using wood blanks, mark the blanks so it is easier to keep the grain running in the same direction when you place them on the mandrel for turning. Use a medium drill speed to **drill** the blanks. Raise the bit from the blank every 1/4" to 1/2" to allow the chips to clear from the flutes of the drill bit. Don't force the drill bit; use an even pressure and let the bit do the work. After drilling the blanks, **sand** the exterior of the brass tubes to roughen their surface and use CA **glue** to glue the tubes inside the blanks. Sand or barrel trim to **square** the ends of the blanks.

## TURNING THE STYLUS

**Set up** the mandrel as shown in Diagram C. Slide the tip bushing on the mandrel followed by the lower (longer) barrel, the center bushing, the smaller barrel, and then the cap bushing. **Turn** the blanks down to the bushings, then **sand** with abrasives and **finish** with your choice of polish.
